**Q5**

In your own words, describe why it is significant that God created us “in His image.” How should this affect the way we view ourselves and the people around us?

**Q6**

What can we learn about human beings and their relationship with God and each other by reading Genesis 2?

**Q7**

Take some time to consider the picture of the world presented in Genesis 1–2. Why is this picture so appealing? Which aspects of life in the garden of Eden should we long to see restored in our world?
